

EURES (European Employment Services) is a European network of employment services coordinated by ELA (European Labour Authority) that aims to facilitate the free movement of workers within EU/EEA countries and Switzerland, as well as to promote fair labour mobility. EURES provides free services to jobseekers searching for employment in Europe and to European employers looking for a workforce in these countries.

EURES advisers provide information, counselling and recruitment services to **jobseekers in Europe**.

For European employers interested in workers from EU/EEA countries and Switzerland, EURES offers professional advice and assistance with recruitment.

EURES has been operating in Slovakia since May 1, 2004 when the Slovak Republic became a member of the European Union. EURES services are provided in Slovakia by **28 EURES advisers** working at selected PES offices. They are also availabe online through job portals eures.sk and eures.europa.eu. EURES in Slovakia is managed by the **National Coordination Office** at the central PES office in Bratislava.

EURES IN FIGURES



14,123 contacts with clients

60 % of clients were jobseekers registered with the Offices of Labour, Social Affairs and Family. More than a third were students, employees looking for a new job or information about living and working in another country.





3,349 registered CVs

84 % of CVs were sent by applicants from Slovakia. 16 % were CVs of jobseekers from other countries.





1,680 employed

Through job fairs and selection interviews, **513** clients were employed. **1,167** of them were helped with job placement individually by EURES.

More than half of EURES clients found a job in Germany and Austria, 15 % in the Czech Republic, 9 % in the Netherlands, but also in Hungary, Italy, Greece, Finland, Switzerland, Croatia and Norway.



3,223 contacts with employers

82 % of them were contacts with employers from other EU/EEA Member States and Switzerland. Two thirds of contacts were focused on recruitment. The remaining third was devoted to specific advice on mobility and working conditions.



4,477 job vacancies

published in 773 job offers. Most job offers were posted in the months of April, March, January and July.

EURES advisers visited more than 110 primary or secondary schools and higher education institutions in 2023, thus introducing the European labour market to **5,738 pupils and students.** Group counselling was given to **8,703 graduates and other jobseekers.**

From the ranks of employers and other partners, **1,246** people participated in the group information activities.

2.1 HUNGARIAN DAY

The aim of the 7th International Job Fair was to present living and working conditions in the cross-border region, to connect employers with jobseekers seeking job opportunities in Hungary and to introduce traineeship and internship possibilities to secondary school and university students.

International Job Fair in figures:

2.2 EURES JOB DAY

The first editon of the International Job Fair was organised by EURES Slovakia in cooperation with the Central Office of Labour, Social Affairs and Family. The main objective of the event was to create space for personal meetings of foreign and Slovak employers with jobseekers interested in working in EU/EEA countries and in Slovakia.



2.3 INTERNSHIPS presentations and recruitment events

INTERNSHIPS GREECE

The cooperation between EURES Slovakia and the luxury beach resort Sani/Ikos is focused on recruitment and paid internships of 3-6 months for gastronomy and business students.

In 2023, the following were registered:

- 56 jobs;
- **34 placements** (9 work contracts, 25 interns students).

INTERNSHIPS AUSTRIA

EURES Slovakia, in cooperation with AMS Austrian labour offices, has offered internships in the field of tourism to students of vocational secondary schools during the winter season 2023/2024.

In 2023, there were:

- 5 7 planned placements;
- 15 registered students of gastronomy and tourism secondary vocational schools (Nitra – 10, Michalovce 2, Prievidza 2, Púchov 1);
- **2 placements** in 2023 (more planned in 2024).

4.1 EURES IN ACTION

The main theme of the 6th EURES in Action event which took place in hybrid form on June 13 - 14 in Bratislava, was labour mobility trends, and skills and occupation shortages. The aim was to exchange expertise, collaborate and share the practical experiences of EURES members.



EURES is a human network made up of EURES advisers operating in all EU/EEA countries and Switzerland. The cooperation of national networks is a key prerequisite for achieving the common objectives of the network.









The European EURES network follows the common **Communication Strategy for 2021-2024** while the implementation of activities depends on the decision of the EURES National Coordination Offices of each Member State and is applied according to the specific conditions of these countries.

notifications and news sent by e-mail, possibility to create a CV in different language mutations.







6.2 SOCIAL MEDIA




Number of contributions posted in EURES Slovakia accounts in 2023:




Engagement (comments, likes, post shares) in 2023:
